

Repair News: Fr Adrian has sought professional advice and an insurance assessment to enable the repairs to the right-hand side of the Sanctuary by the Altar Rails. The leak is in the South Aisle, not where we had a previous repair, but the area has been closed off, with the route to take after Communion/Blessing clearly marked to avoid the troubled area. As soon as we have more news on the repair costs, we will let you know once we have details.

Development News: please note that the Parish and Diocesan Finance Committee hope to carry out some improvement works to certain areas of the Parish Hall. As soon as news becomes available further details will be posted via the newsletter, at Mass and in the church. It will mean that, for a period of months the Hall will be closed for a set time, at a date that is to be determined. The Parish is informing all Hall users of this as it is hoped that all evening users will continue this September and possibly into 2023 depending on the areas of the Hall being worked on at the time.
