### **Pope Francis's Prayer Intention for June 2019**

This month's prayer intention is aimed at the mode of life for priests in committing to solidarity with the poor, but in fact this is a commitment we all need to adopt. Firstly, we need to learn something about ourselves and our own attitudes. It is hard to have empathy for the poor, if we cannot really understand what it is like to walk in someone else's shoes. It is hard to have empathy with the poor if we cannot ditch the instinct to sit in judgement. It is hard to have empathy for the poor if we cannot let go of some or all of our privileges. This month we are asked to join in Pope Francis's prayer intention, "... That priests, through the modesty and humility of their lives, commit themselves actively to a solidarity with those who are poorest."
