Sacramental Programmes for 2023/2024. Confirmation. Will parents, please note, for the Youth Group and Confirmation Programme to go ahead we need your help this year. Each family wanting to join the Youth Group is asked for at least one parent to volunteer to be on a rota of three to four parents each week who will act as helpers as per Safeguarding regulations. You won't be expected to teach Catechism but will be needed to help with the planned refreshments and basic team activities/games on a Friday at an agreed time and with dates to

follow. Full information will be given at a parent meeting once the closing date for applications to the Youth Group ends.

Holy Communion: All parents who signed-up, to join the programme, should have received an email from Fr Adrian. If you cannot see yours, please check your email 'Junk box', as the email may have gone there, thank you.

Can you spare some time to help us on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October? Please do not delay returning the Parish form until you have all the school forms, as Fr Adrian needs time to collate the information. Please make sure you are aware of each School's cut-off date, e.g., Secondary Schools will need their completed forms over the next few weeks. Please remember that at least a week is needed to give time to process the forms so that forms handed in one Sunday are usually returned the next week. Please see Fr Adrian if you have any questions, thank you.
