### Third Sunday of Advent: Parish Mass Book p. 88

On the third Sunday of Advent we particularly remember that **Advent prepares us for a time of joy; with the colour rose acting as a symbol of the mix of the purple of penance and preparation joined with the white of the expectation and joy of Christmas.** Our Jesse Tree symbols have continued to remind us of the Old Testament stories of salvation in the history of God's people: the **Passover Lamb**, pointing us again to God's care and the sacrifice that Jesus made for us; the **Ten Commandments**, reminding us of ways that bring out the best in us and how we should try to live our lives, in relation to God and those around us. Ultimately, God's greatest Commandment of Love should be written on our hearts, so that we witness, in action, to God's love.



Further symbols of action we had this week were the **Ram's Horn** trumpet that Joshua used to bring down the walls of Jericho in response to God's call; a **Crown** to represent how Samuel anointed David as King – a forerunner of Christ, the King of Kings – a **Shepherd's Crook** to remind us how David was to look after his people, but which represents Jesus as the true Shepherd who seeks and cares for us always. The **Altar** this Sunday represents the altar built by Elijah and reminds us of the altar of Christ's sacrifice for us.

**A message from the family of the late Edward Barnes RIP**

We are very grateful to Fr Adrian and all at St Mary Magdalen's for Edward's family to donate an icon of the Angel Gabriel as a memorial to Edward Barnes. This lovely church was such an important part of Edward's life, particularly since his early retirement. For the quarter-century which followed he devoted himself to the parish. He studied pastoral theology at Heythrop College, went to Mass daily whenever possible, became a Eucharistic minister, took Holy Communion to the sick and conducted Eucharistic services when the priest was absent. He died at the age of 92 in September 2021. In his memory St Mary Magdalen has been given an artwork by his family. It shows the archangel Gabriel; the model for the figure is Edward's grandson Joseph.

**A BIG THANK YOU to all those who were able to buy their Christmas Trees from the church on Saturday. The rail works and the closure of the level crossings didn't help last Saturday, but we were able to raise the wonderful amount of £1008 for the charitable work of our Parish.** Every penny counts, as we have just learnt that in 2022 changes to the Diocesan banking arrangements will mean that we incur bank charges on every transaction. This means the more electronic payments we have the less our charges will be. The help of all our volunteers and the resources each one of us can provide are a vital help to the work of our church. The funds raised by our Advent candle and Christmas Tree sales will go towards the £15, 000 needed for the urgent safety repairs to the roofing areas in the Hall, Parish/PTA store and the Cemetery walkway.

**Primary School Applications for 2022**

Please note that all parents applying for a school reference are requested to see Fr Adrian to obtain and complete a Parish request for each child seeking a place. This is a Parish form, not the school one and is called the **"Parish Request Form."** This form can be collected from Fr Adrian after every Sunday Mass. Requests for references are dealt with in the order that they have been received from the parents and/or schools concerned so **please be aware of application closure dates** and that references can only be handed in or collected after Mass on Sunday. **If you have any questions about the applications, please see Fr Adrian after Mass to book an appointment to discuss the process.**

**Please note: parents have to provide Fr Adrian with the Catholic School SIF for him to complete and some parents have not yet done this. If you are applying to the Parish School Fr Adrian will hand the SIF to the school himself, if you are applying to other Catholic or even non-Catholic schools then you need to provide Fr Adrian with the SIF and follow the school instructions. If Fr Adrian has to send the form to the school on your behalf you must include a stamped, addressed envelope with enough postage to cover the cost of postage according to the size of the envelope.** Please be aware of application closure dates and that references can only be handed in or collected after Mass on Sunday.
