If you're applying to a Catholic School for September 2023, please see Fr Adrian after Mass to obtain a form called the "Parish Reference Request". This form, with family photo and a COPY of the child's baptism certificate, together with any school forms for Fr Adrian to complete (if you already have them) must be handed back to Fr Adrian at the end of the usual Sunday Mass you attend. Please do not delay returning the Parish form until you have all the school forms, as Fr Adrian needs time to collate the information. Please make sure you are aware of each School's cut-off date, e.g., Secondary Schools need completed forms for October 2022. Fr Adrian cannot provide a reference if you have not seen him at Mass to obtain the "Parish Reference Request".

With Half Term coming up, please do not leave it until the last minute to see Fr Adrian, as the last possible collection date is the Sunday of Half Term (23rd October). Fr Adrian suggests, in case there are any issues or delays, that you see him at the latest this Sunday Sunday 2nd October. This is so that forms can be ready for collection on Sunday 9th or 23rd October. This is because Fr Adrian is attending a Wedding Celebration that Sunday and there is a visiting Priest for all the Masses on 16th October. If you cannot get the forms to Fr Adrian any earlier then please note that you will have to drop your Parish Reference Request Form and any school SIF papers off in person on Sunday 9th October for the collection on Sunday 23rd October. If you have already seen Fr Adrian you will remember he sates that he can complete the Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP) which Westminster Schools use instead of the Priests SIF. If you require any CCP's then you must write on the Parish Form how many you need when you write down the Schools you are applying to, thank you.

Farewill to the Montessori Nursery at St Mary Magdalen Parish. Since the year 2000, Elizabeth Maitland (Liz) has been running the Montessori nursery in the Hall. Sadly, as the Parish Hall is over 100 years old, much maintance has been needed, with £55,000 spent by the Parish alone on the Hall in the last three years, added to the contribution of the nursery investments from Liz Maitland. The nursery lease came to an end last week and the nursery children and staff have moved on, as the further maintenance and care needed to the Parish Hall could not allow a nursey to be managed there during the extended work. The Parish and Trustees of the Diocese would like to thank Liz Maitland, the staff and children over those nearly 23 years for their enthusism and care and Liz asked Fr Adrian to express her thanks to all in the Parish over those years of working together. We thank Liz and her staff for all their hard work and generosity over the years and pray for the staff and children for the new term.

Some advance notice that the annual Harvest CAFOD Fast Day collection will be taken on Sunday 8th October.


