Plenary Indulgences and our care for the Holy Souls

It is important at this time of year to learn the importance of how the Church teaches that we care for those who have died through our prayers for them. Information can be found in the Church's Catechism CCC1680-1690 (for an online version click HERE in the digital newsletter). This year Pope Francis has declared that a plenary indulgence can received for yourself or for the Holy Souls by visiting a church or cemetery and reciting an Our Father and the Creed on any day in November. A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin. The indulgence cleanses a person of all temporal punishment due to sin. Information can be found in the Church's Catechism CCC1471-1498 (for an online version click HERE)
