CELEBRATING THE HOLY SOULS: on hearing of the recent deaths, including two children, following the sinking of a migrant boat, Bishop Paul McAleenan said "All who value human life, whatever their position on migrants and refugees, will be united in sorrow following the tragedy."

Each November the Church takes time to remember those who have died and makes the positive step of praying and offering Mass for the repose of their souls. Following this tradition, as each year, we will have the opportunity to request Masses for the Holy Souls and write lists of remembrance with the names of our dear departed friends and family. As the Solemnity of All Saints falls on Sunday, we will be remembering especially all those who have died at our 11am Sunday Masses and November Lists of Remembrance can be placed in the basket by the Altar at any time or emailed to Fr Adrian at the Parish Office:

all those who have fallen as armed personnel or civilians in the two World Wars and subsequent conflicts for our Remembrance Sunday next week.



Any adult who wishes to learn more about their faith or to be baptised or confirmed is invited to email their interest to Fr Adrian at Mortlake@RCAOS.org.uk. If you would like to be baptised or confirmed as an adult, or if you've been baptised in another church and would like to be Received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church then please get in touch for the opportunity to learn more about the faith and ask any questions you may have. This process is called the **Rite of Catholic Initiation in Adulthood** or **RCIC** if a child is prepared around the age of Holy Communion. If you are a Catholic parent of a child who has not been baptised or was baptised into another Christian congregation, please see Fr Adrian if you would like them to make their First Holy Communion at St Mary Magdalen's next year.

It is important to note that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass continues to remain suspended.

Our church is only able to open at set times when there are enough volunteers to clean the church before and after.

Confirmation and First Holy Communion News for 2020 into 2021

Sadly, Bishop Paul has definitely postponed the **Confirmation** due for December this year, but **we await definite news on whether our classes can start with the aim of celebrating Confirmation in February 2021**. Given the need for socially-distanced classes and Masses, our numbers will be reduced, but Fr Adrian is checking with the Catechists to see what's possible. If your child is currently in Year 9 or Year 10 and they would like to apply to be confirmed, please email Fr Adrian at Mortlake@RCAOS.org.uk with "**Confirmation 2021**" as the subject. If we have enough Catechists and Candidates it may be possible for Bishop Paul to celebrate Confirmation on 6 February 2021, so please email Fr Adrian to express your interest as soon as possible so as to not lose the opportunity. **Under present guidelines, our Covid counter-measures allow classes, but please be aware that possible future lockdown measures may mean that candidates could have a mix of home study with socially-distanced group sessions when possible.** Thank you.

Please note: If your child is in Year 3 at St Mary Magdalen's school, applications have been issued for the **celebration of next year's Sacrament of First Holy Communion**. Please Note: from this weekend we start a 4-week trial where blocks of seats are reserved in the church and Parishioners register at the door by scanning the NHS Venue Code or provide their name and phone number. This trial is to see if we can manage without the seat-booking system. We will continue to reserve seats for our Parish seniors during this trial, however, if we have more than 90 people turn up a seat cannot be guaranteed, so please bear with us during the trial.
