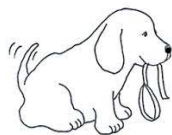

Some Development News: please note that the Parish and Diocesan Finance Committee hope to carry out some improvement works to certain areas of the Parish Hall. It will mean that, for a period of months the Hall will be closed for a set time, at a date that is to be determined. The Parish is informing all Hall users of this as it is hoped that all evening users will continue this September and possibly into 2023 depending on the areas of the Hall being worked on at the time.

Our "Children's Liturgy" at the 9.30 am Mass on Sunday News. Next Sunday 17th July is the final day for our Children's Liturgy before the summer holidays.
