Mass Book p.91-93 Celebrating Fathers' Day: on Sunday we remember especially our fathers: all those living with us, those separated by geography or circumstances and all those who have gone before us to the Lord.

The opportunity for Holy Communion under both kinds: The Bishops of our country recently lifted the restrictions that had been placed during the Pandemic preventing the sharing of the chalice. We are still able to receive the Blessed Sacrament on the hand or tongue and receive the fullness of Christ in one kind this way and no one is obliged to take Holy

Communion under both kinds. The instruction on the "Doctrinal Formation and Communion Under Both Kinds" states that "the Council of Trent ... emphasizes that "nothing is lost by the body being received by the people without the blood: because the priest both offers and receives the blood in the name of all, and the whole Christ is present under either species" (Summa Theologiae, III, g. 80, a. 12, ad 3).

So, under the species of bread there is also present, by concomitance, the precious blood. The purpose, then, of receiving Holy Communion under both kinds, is not that the

faithful receive more grace than when they receive it under one kind alone, but that the faithful are enabled to appreciate vividly the value of the sign."

Although we will carry on receiving Holy Communion on the hand, if your preference is to receive both the Blessed Sacrament and the Precious Blood, then please come to Fr Adrian at Communion, as only the Priest is able to offer the Eucharist by intinction (dipping the host into the Precious Blood and placing this on the communicant's tongue). Please note: it is not possible to receive by intinction onto the hand.

This form, with a family photo and a COPY of the child's baptism certificate, together with any school forms for Fr Adrian to complete (the school SIF if you already have them) are to be handed back to Fr Adrian at the end of the usual Sunday Mass you attend. Please do not delay returning the Parish form until you have all the school forms, as Fr Adrian needs time to collate the information. Please make sure you are aware of each School's cut-off date, e.g. Secondary Schools will need their completed forms over the next few weeks.

Please remember that at least a week is needed to give time to process the forms so that forms handed in one Sunday are usually returned the next week. Please see Fr Adrian if you have any questions.
