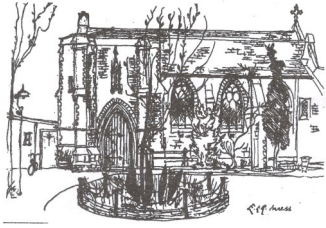




# BUILDING TOGETHER

Thank you for helping to support the charitable work of the parish and the care and maintenance of our beautiful Victorian church

Our magnificent church with its Grade II\* Listed Mausoleum is over 170 years old and has many repair needs, such as crumbling walls and leaking roofs, so we need to raise £1,500 a week but only take in roughly £400 to £700. To help raise this amount we held a second collection on the first weekend of each month before the Pandemic and will restart this once a month. To ensure that we can help care for the church **we invite parish members to a new planned giving scheme, BUILDING TOGETHER** where, by praying and planning what's possible to give within a person's needs, tax-payers and non-tax payers alike can pledge a sum each week or each month to help ensure that our church can be a beacon of Christ's Light in Mortlake for another 170 years and many more to come.

**We don't ask you to give a certain amount**, as this varies according to a person's income, but please consider the total amount you give each week or each month to the general needs and charitable work of the Parish. **We are all in difficult financial positions from the current state of our economy and not everyone may be able to pledge financially, but we hope people can donate their time and talents to help the Parish as well.** If you are in a position to pledge an extra 10% or the equivalent of an hour's wage then please return the form overleaf. The monies raised will be ring-fenced towards the specific health and safety renovation, repair and maintenance work which we have to undertake over the next 20 years. Details of the work are displayed on the Building Together information board in the church, but a summary of costs is given below. Please remember to sign the Gift Aid Declaration overleaf if you are able to.
