New Apostolic Nuncio to Great Britain At a special Mass to welcome the new Apostolic Nuncio to Great Britain on the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord, Cardinal Nichols described the Catholics of England and Wales as "a faithful people" with a "depth of faith in our history and in our hearts." Archbishop Buendia succeeds Archbishop Claudio Gugerotti, who was recently appointed Prefect to the Eastern Churches. As is usual our new Apostilic Nuncia will reside in the Nunciature in Wimbledon. The Apostolic Nuncio is the personal representative of Pope Francis to the Court of St James's – the royal court for the Sovereign of the UK. His role is equivalent to that of an ambassador, representing the Holy See to the UK Government. Cardinal Nichols said a new nuncio is a "gift" to us all and "a way of strengthening our communion with Peter and of us taking our place in the Catholic Church throughout the world."
