Would you like your child to receive First Holy Communion next year?

If your child will be in Year 3 from September 2023, whether they are in our Parish School, another Catholic School or in a Non-Catholic School please the details below. Each year we have some children who have not yet been baptised or are from different faith traditions, so if that applies to you, an extra application is needed for your child to become Catholic.

Would you like your child to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2024?

All Parish Youth in Year 9 and above are invited to learn more about faith in a new Parish Youth Group from Autumn 2023. Those who attend Mass from the Youth Group will then have the opportunity to apply for the Sacrament of Confirmation. join the Parish Youth Group to express interest in the Confirmation Programme. **Parents, please note, for the Youth Group and Confirmation Programme to go ahead we need your help this year. Each family wanting to join the Youth Group is asked for at least one parent to volunteer to be on a rota of three to four parents each week who will act as helpers as per Safeguarding regulations. You won't be expected to teach Catechism, but will be needed to help with refreshments and basic team activities/games. Full information will be given at a parents meeting once the closing date for applications to the Youth Group ends on 15 October 2023, thank you.**

Will you be going abroad this summer? If so, please remember the charity Mary's Meals by donating unused currency you bring home with you. Please take one of the envelopes from the table, at the back of the church, fill it with your unused and unwanted foreign currency and send it to the address provided. All donations received will help towards providing school meals to children living in some of the world's poorest countries.

Our "Children's Liturgy" at the 9.30 am Family Mass on Sunday. It is wonderful that we have a few amazing volunteers for Children's Liturgy, as it's a great blessing having their help. We will be taking a summer break but would like to ask of those families who come along to the Family Mass, if you would be able to help an existing volunteer leader. Each September we are often joined by more families, so we plan to host some refreshments after the Family Mass at the beginning of the School year to help families know what's involved in being part of the Children's Liturgy group.

If you currently attend Children's Liturgy, but don't yet help as a leader or group helper, please speak to Fr Adrian, Helena or one of the other parent helpers before the end of term, as this will help us to plan for September's meeting.

Catholic Nursery/Reception, Secondary School Transfers and 6th Form Applications for 2024

If you're applying to a Catholic School for next year, please see Fr Adrian after Mass to obtain a form called the **Parish Reference Request**". This form, with a family photo and a COPY of the child's baptism certificate, together with any school forms for Fr Adrian to complete (the school SIF if you already have them) are to be handed back to Fr Adrian at the end of the usual Sunday Mass you attend. Please do not delay returning the Parish form until you have all the school forms, as Fr Adrian needs time to collate the information. Please make sure you are aware of each School's cut-off date, e.g., Secondary Schools will need their completed forms over the next few weeks. Please remember that at least a week is needed to give time to process the forms so that forms handed in one Sunday are usually returned the next week. Please see Fr Adrian if you have any questions.
