### Stations of the Cross ...

If you can please join us for 'Stations of the Cross', on Sundays at 10.30 am, between the 9.30 and 11 am Masses during Lent, thank you. Although having fish on a Friday is still held as a practice by many people, the origins of this custom come from Catholic practice of Fridays being special days of fasting. Since 2011, Catholics in this country have been called to live-out Fridays as days of fasting as a practice of penance, whereby penance is what we do, not as a punishment, but as a positive witness of recognising our shortcomings.
